## Who are the Lokahi Foundation?

- Founded by Rachael Natoli, after leaving a long-term abusive relationship.
- At the Lokahi Foundation, we provide a wide range of support services for women who have been victims of Domestic and Family abuse. Our experienced caseworkers will deliver ongoing support that is designed to help survivors regain their freedom and independence, physically, emotionally, practically and financially, with support continuing for as long as each individual needs it.
- The Lokahi Foundation strives to walk alongside women, empowering them to explore their options and keep safe. We recognise the numerous challenges women face when in this circumstance, and support them to gain the skills necessary to live a life free from abuse.
- Lokahi (Low-kar-he) is a Hawaiian word meaning 'harmony' and 'unity'. It represents our aim for the women we support, by working together with all the other agencies and organisations they may need and use.





# Rachael's Story

The Lokahi Foundation was started after Rachael Natoli left a long-term Domestic and Family Abuse relationship and rebuilt her life with the support of her caseworker.

In April 2015, after one final physical and emotional incident of abuse, Rachael finally found the strength to contact the police, and take the necessary steps to leave her husband with her young twins. However, that was only the start of the journey, and one that she couldn't have survived without her caseworker at her side.

Rachael and her young twins left with few belongings, no car and no money. They had five different "homes" in seven weeks, the children were placed on the Family Law Watchlist to prevent them going on a previously-planned holiday to the UK, and all Rachael's family were back in England so she had very little support.

Her caseworker went above and beyond in the level of care and support she provided and Rachael realised that if everyone had a caseworker like her, more abuse victims would leave, stay away and move on with their lives independently.
